Please send one entry per dog running the trial. **Entry fees MUST be in Canadian Funds.** A listing fee of \$9.41 (including GST) must accompany each entry for those dogs not registered in Canada, or for those dogs that do not hold an Event Registration Number. CKC registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the trial or all wins and awards will be cancelled. Application forms are available online at www.ckc.ca. Refunds must be requested in writing and must be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. Make all fees payable to the FVRTC.

Dead ducks will be used in this trial. Males and females will be run in order of the draw. A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the All-Age Stakes. Wingers may be used in all stakes. Female dogs will not be vetted and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC Licensed Trial. Eliminated dogs will be allowed to run out of contention in the minor stakes as time allows. **New CKC ruling:** Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC.
