DIRECTIONS TO DANNY'S ESSO AND TO HEADQUARTERS, THE PORT ROBINSON COMMUNITY CENTRE:

For Danny's Esso: Signs for each stake will be clearly visible from this corner.

From Toronto, take QEW to Niagara. Exit at Hwy. 406 to Welland. There is a new overpass at Hwy. 20, so go towards Niagara, then over the liftbridge to the stoplight at the intersection of Hwys. 20 & 58.

From U.S., take QEW to the Thorold Stone Rd. exit, towards Thorold. Turn left on Hwy. 58. Continue to Hwy. 20.

For Headquarters and tailgate: **Go south on Hwy. 58 from Danny's Esso towards Port Robinson. Go over the tracks and turn right at the flashing light. Road curves to the left past the firehall. Then turn left on Cross St. to the Port Robinson Community Centre.**
