DEFINITION OF STAKES

PUPPY For dogs 6 month of age but not over 1 year on the day of the trial

JUNIOR For dogs not over 2 years on the day of the trial

QUALIFYING For dogs how have never won 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th or a certificate of merit in an Open All Age stake nor a 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th in an Amateur All Age Stake nor have won 5 Qualityings

OPEN ALL AGE For dogs over 6 months of age

AMATEUR ALL AGE For dogs over 6 months if handled by a person deemed an Amateur by the Field Trial Committee
