ENTRIES

The Qualifying and Junior stakes will be run together, therefore, dogs cannot be entered in both stakes on the same day.

1. Make cheques, dated no latter than the closing date, payable to the Manitoba Gun Dog Association. **Please mail early.**

3. **Entries CLOSE Thursday June 2, 2016.**
4. Draw at 8:00 PM on Monday, June 2, 2016 at the home of the Field Trial Secretary.
5. All dogs will run in the order drawn. In All Age Stakes rotation will be used. The starting dog number in the first series of the Open on Saturday and Sunday will be determined by using the last two digits at closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE) S&P/TSX composite index on the Thursday immediately preceding the trial.
6. A separate OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORM for EACH DOG in EACH STAKE is required.
7. All entries must be accompanied by the Entry fees and, if applicable, the Listing fees. A Listing fee of \$9.30, which includes GST, per dog per event is payable unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.
8. **No phone entries.**

Non Member Participation Fee "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian non CKC members and are

not applicable to CKC members.”

SCRATCHES will forfeit \$15.00. To be considered, “NO SHOW” refunds must be requested in writing to the Field Trial Secretary no later than fourteen days after the trial, explaining the reason for the scratch.

DUCKS and/or PHEASANTS may be used in all stakes.

STANDARD CKC ROSETTES will be awarded for all placings and CMs in each stake.

CAMPING and TRAILER PARKING available. No electrical hook ups; no water.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Any person participating in any capacity at a field trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial-giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to all parties concerned. It shall also within ten days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of the report indicating that this rule has been violated.

Caution: The Manitoba Gun Dog Association Inc. will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment, whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore the Manitoba Gun Dog Association Inc. will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to event participants, bystanders, club members, workers or other individuals using the property for any purpose.
