Female dogs will not be vetted and handlers are reminded that bitches in estrus cannot compete in a CKC licensed Trial.

Starting dog in the Open will be determined by the TSX closing on Thursday May 5th, 2016.

A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the All Age Stakes.
