ENTRIES

The Qualifying and Junior will be run together, therefore, dogs cannot be entered in both stakes on the same day.

Time permitting minor stake dogs will be allowed to run all tests after they have been eliminated.

1. Make cheques, dated no later than the closing date, payable to the Manitoba Gun Dog Association. **Please mail early.**

3. Draw at 8:00 PM on Tuesday, August 27, 2019 at the home of the Field Trial Secretary.
4. All dogs will run in the order drawn. In All Age Stakes rotation will be used. The starting dog in the first series of the All-Age stakes will be determined by using the last two digits (including digits, if any to the right of the decimal point) of the closing S&P/TSX composite index (the TSX number) on Thursday, August 29, 2019.
5. A separate OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORM for EACH DOG in EACH STAKE is required.
6. All entries must be accompanied by the Entry fees and, if applicable, the Listing fees. A Listing fee of \$10.50, GST included, per dog per event is payable unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.
7. **No phone entries.**

Non-Member Participation Fee "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian non CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

SCRATCHES will forfeit \$15.00. To be considered, "NO SHOW" refunds must be requested in writing to the Field Trial Secretary no later than fourteen days after the trial, explaining the reason for the scratch.

DUCKS and/or PHEASANTS may be used in all stakes.

STANDARD CKC ROSETTES will be awarded for all placings and CMs in each stake.

CAMPING and TRAILER PARKING are available at the MGDA grounds. No electrical hook ups; no water.

THE ALL AGE ENTRY FEE INCLUDES THE NRCC \$5.00 SURCHARGE

NRCC member clubs are collecting \$5.00 per dog competing in each All Age Stake held. Fees collected will be submitted to the NRCC Treasurer. At the end of the trial season, 100% of the funds collected will be distributed retroactively to the Host Club(s) for that year.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS AND JUDGES

3.8 Indignities to a Judge

3.8.1 A judge officiating at a field trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the field trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the field trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

3.9 Judge's Conduct

3.9.1 A judge must conduct himself in a manner that is fair and not prejudicial to the sport.

21.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

The Manitoba Gun Dog Association Inc. will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment, whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore the Manitoba Gun Dog Inc. will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to event participants, bystanders, club members, workers or other individuals using the property for any purpose.
