PAYMENT: Please make cheques payable to the Niagara Peninsula Retriever Training Club. An \$11.30 listing fee must accompany any entry form of dogs for which an individual CKC registration or ERN number is not shown. Separate entry forms must be completed for each stake the dog is entered. Scratches/refunds for dogs withdrawn after the closing date for reasons other than stated in the CKC Retriever Field Trial Rule book will not have their entry fees refunded. All fees to be in Canadian funds, no exchange will be given on U.S. funds.

GAME: Dead ducks will be used in all stakes.

RUNNING ORDER: We will utilize the 2 ending digits in the TSX as of the close of business on Wednesday May 12 as a starting number for the first series of All Age Stakes. Judges will impose a system of rotations thereafter in the All Age Stakes.

AWARDS: CKC rosettes will be awarded to all placing dogs in each stake. CKC rosettes will also be awarded to dogs earning a Certificate of Merit.

CKC INFORMATION: NPRTC is a member of the National Retriever Club of Canada and dogs placing in our CKC approved Licensed Trial will be eligible to compete in the National Stakes. *Excerpt from CKC Rules and Regulations for Field Trials:* Sec. 21.7 – ‘It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS: By entering this Trial each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to the participation in the Trial and agrees to release and save harmless and indemnify the owners of any property upon which the Trial is held together with their officers, agents, employees and Representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participants howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.
