DIRECTIONS TO SITE

Take Hwy 101 from Halifax towards the Annapolis Valley. Take exit 4 off Hwy 101 (St. Croix) Turn right off the off ramp and continue straight for 3 km. Turn left onto Hwy 215. Proceed 3.4 km to the McKay Road. Turn right onto the McKay Road and proceed 1.5 km to # 294 McKay Road. Signs will be posted at all turns from exit 4 on Hwy 101 to the test HQ's.

Release and indemnification of Landowners

By entering this Hunt Test, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the test and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the test is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant, or his heirs, his executors and assigns.

Section 18.7 CKC Hunt Test Rules and Regulations

It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at the hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
