Test Information

1. Ducks or pheasants will be used on land and ducks will be used on water.
2. Bitches in season may not compete and must be withdrawn. Entry fees will be refunded to the participant provided a veterinary certificate is given to the Hunt Secretary prior to the start of the test.
3. CKC Rosettes will be given to all dogs that pass their test.
4. Dark or camouflage clothing must be worn for all tests.

24-12-3. CKC Non-member Participation Fee

a)An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee (\$57.60).

b)In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

c)The Premium List must carry a note stating that “This only applies to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.”

Chapter 18 - Section 7 – It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Hwy #401 Eastbound – Exit #509 – Go straight through at stop sign. Turn left at next stop sign onto Cty. Rd. #26. Go north about 2km. to Long Reach Road. Turn right and go to end of road to Gahonk Kennels. Watch for signs
