Confirmation of draw numbers may be emailed if possible. Running lists will be forwarded to the National Website and the York Website as finalized.

- **Please check in with the Marshal upon arrival at your stake.** It is the responsibility of the handler to inform the Marshal if they have dogs running in other stakes, and the Marshal has the authority to move dogs for the efficiency of the test.
- Game birds (ducks) will be used.
- Shotguns may not necessarily be used. However, handlers may be required to handle a gun or replica during the test. Gun Safety is considered as part of the test
- All handlers **MUST** wear dark or camouflage clothing.
- Handlers are expected to be familiar with the CKC Rules and Regulations for Hunt Tests.

Important: The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles. The York Retriever Field Trial Club is a member in good standing of The Canadian National Master.

The listing fee of \$9.61 per dog must be submitted for any dog not having an individual registration number.

Standard CKC Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs successfully completing test requirements. Presentations will be made at the completion of each stake.

ALL SCRATCHES MUST BE REPORTED TO THE FIELD TRAIL SECRETARY 24 HOURS BEFORE THE TRIAL. Entry fees will be refunded only for bitches in season or for injured dogs, upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate. Once the catalogue has been printed, a \$10.00 surcharge will apply.

Notice to Trialer's: Chapter 20, Section 5 of the Field Trial Rules and Regulations states: Any person participating in any capacity at a Field Trial held under these rules shall not be subject to an indignity of any kind. It shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the trial giving Club of an alleged indignity of any kind the Field Committee of the Club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within ten days after its trial report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its finding. The Board of Directors of the CKC shall have the power to take such actions as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
