



#### PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

**National Field Trial Champion NFTCH -** The National Field Trial Champion title, NFTCH, is awarded to the winner of the National Retriever Championship stake.

**National Amateur Field Trial Champion NAFTCH** - The National Amateur Field Trial Champion title, NAFTCH, is awarded to the top Amateur handled dog when the winner is handled by a Professional and the top Amateur handled dog completes the 10<sup>th</sup> series of the National Retriever Championship stake.

**National Finalists** are the dogs who complete the 10<sup>th</sup> series without an eliminating fault.



**CKC Rule 14.4.1** The winner of the National Retriever Championship Stake shall become a Field Trial Champion of Record and shall be entitled to be designated the National Field Trial Champion of "year".

**CKC Rule 14.5.1** When the winner of the National Retriever Championship is handled by a Professional, the National Amateur Field Trial Champion title, NAFTCH, is awarded to the top Amateur handled dog who has completed the 10th series of the National Retriever Championship stake shall become an Amateur Field Trial Champion of Record and shall be entitled to be designated the National Amateur Field Trial Champion of "year".



I would like to thank the Vancouver Island Retriever club and everyone involved for their efforts in planning and organizing this National.



# NATIONAL RETRIEVER CLUB OF CANADA'S ON THE GROUNDS BEHAVIOUR AND CONDUCT

- 1. In the National Retriever Championship stake, the "Guidelines for Ethical Training at Nationals" has been adopted. As much training may be done as required BEFORE entering the trial grounds or AFTER running a test. NO TRAINING may be done after observing a test until you have run. After a series has been officially set up by the judges, during the running of the stake, no competing dog shall, while on the grounds, be exercised, trained or worked with the exception of a bumper thrown by the handler and this only in an especially approved area and only for the purpose of exercising the dog.
- 2. Any dog not entered in the stake and interfering with the running of the stake may be required to be removed.
- 3. Exercise areas to be clearly defined.
- 4. Rules on failure to appear on line when called to be strictly enforced. It is a practice of some competitors to be late when they are Dog Number 1 or 2.
- 5. No dog to be allowed to watch any test having just run the test or not, thus eliminating confusion as to who has run and who has not and reducing the chance of dog fights.
- 6. The starting dog shall be rotated by 1/5 of the remaining field. If the number of dogs is not a whole number, the rotation should go to the next highest whole number. Use the rotation number to count the number of running dogs after the previous starting dog to identify the next starting dog. If that dog has already run first then the next highest dog that has not run first, if any, will do so. No dog should be the starting dog more than once. There shall be a minimum rotation of three dogs.
- 7. The first scheduled test of the National will be announced. Each next scheduled test will be posted with callbacks. The procedure will help create fairness for all by eliminating possible competitive advantages for those involved in putting on the trial. Judges have no obligation to go ahead with a scheduled test as conditions may change.
- 8. White clothing is not allowed in the gallery or behind the line.
- 9. Please note that to qualify to run the National, the host club where you received your placing must be a paid in full member of the NRCC in good standing.

**CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB CAUTION Rule 21.7**: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, and or any participant at an event held under the rules is not subject to indignities. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

#### MORE THAN JUST A COMPETION

The use of trained retrievers in waterfowl and upland game shooting is a vital conservation measure. Anyone who intends to train their dog to this end, would do well to come out and watch the best retrievers in Canada compete. The National attempts to demonstrate all aspects of the work required from a retriever in the field, and to test the natural and trained abilities of the dogs to enable the judges to declare a National Field Trial Champion and a National Amateur Field Trial Champion.

The National Retriever Championship Stake should be comprised of ten (10) tests. Five (5) on land and five (5) in water. The dogs are tested on "marked retrievers", where the dog can see the bird fall and on "blind retrievers" where the birds are hidden.

- In a marked retrieve, the dog is expected to find the birds without any help from their handler. Marks may involve from one (1) to four (4) birds being thrown one after the other and dogs may pick up the birds in any order. Dogs require a tremendous memory to do well on multiple marks although the dogs might not be eliminated for requiring help from their handler but they will be penalized.
- In a blind retrieve, the dog is sent by their handler and should run in a straight line until stopped. One whistle is the signal for the dog to stop and look for direction. Hand signals by their handler, give the dog direction. Dogs that do not respond are penalized. A perfect job is a straight line to the bird.
- All birds used in the National Championship Stake are dead ducks or pheasants.
- If you would like to gain a greater understanding of the Canadian Field Trials for Retrievers, rule books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.

#### TIPS TO THE GALLERY

Never attempt to approach or pet anyone else's dog.

Stay in areas designated by officials.

While dogs are being tested, refrain from loud talking or other noises and unnecessary quick motions. These distractions may seriously interfere with a dog's work.


Withhold applause until the dog has completed the series and is leaving the line.

Plan on wearing dark clothing. White coats, shirts, sweaters, hats etc. will not be permitted in the gallery.

Respect the environment and the landowners by keep the grounds litter free. Fully extinguish all cigarettes and matches.

Non-competing dogs are not allowed on the grounds.





Creating friendships across Canada & the USA and having developed retrievers since the late 1990's with the help of this community, we have been fortunate to have had some success with that endeavour.

Sparky is a Razor-bred Labrador out of Fenn Wizard & Razor's Da Cuttin' Edge. After his first year of puppy basics with us, he went to Dan DeVos for winter training. Sparky's young dog career in Canada started with a Junior 1st & 4th before 10 months of age before he achieved 9 Junior wins including a Qualifying win on the same weekend before 2 years of age. He accumulated 57 points (US and Canada) with a 100% completion in 14 starts.



2018 was the season Sparky started to mature, winning 2 US Qualifying stakes and placing 4th on the same weekend in the Amateur. That same year he was the National runner up, being one of 3 finalists that did not handle on all marking tests. He ended that season with a 2nd & 4th in the Open as a 3 year old.

## **HEAT EXHAUSTION - In Working and Sporting Dogs**

HEATSTROKE is defined as a state of extreme hyperthermia resulting in thermal injury to the tissues. Heatstroke occurs when heat generation exceeds the body's ability to dissipate heat. Dogs with heatstroke often are found to have body temperatures between 106 – 109 degrees F; normal body temperature in the dog is 101 – 105 degrees F.

Because dogs do not have sweat glands, they get rid of body heat through panting. In addition, heat can be released through dilated blood vessels in the skin. For this reason, if you suspect heat-related illness in our dog, you should not put them in cold water, as this will constrict the blood vessels in the skin, leading to less heat loss. Therefore, if heat distress is suspected in your dog, dousing them with lukewarm water should be done right away (for example, using water from a garden hose).

Causes of heatstroke in dogs include obesity, extremes in age, underlying heart or lung disease, brachycephalic facial conformation (for example, bulldogs, pugs, Boston terriers), laryngeal paralysis (as is most often seen in older Labradors), water deprivation, confinement in a poorly ventilated area, lack of environmental acclimatization, and high humidity in combination with a high ambient temperature.

The physical effects of heatstroke can be devastating. Tissue damage occurs due to the high body temperature, and the tissue damage worsens the longer the dog is hyperthermic. For this reason, it is very important to cool your dog prior to transport to a veterinarian. Again, cold water should be avoided. Wet your dog quickly with lukewarm water, and then take them to a veterinarian right away. One veterinary study showed that only 38% of dogs died if they were cooled prior to presentation to a veterinarian, whereas 61% died if they were not cooled prior to transport. Heatstroke can cause damage to every body system, including brain (seizures), gastrointestinal tract (bloody diarrhea and vomiting), liver, (liver failure), kidneys (kidney failure), and clotting system (causing massive bleeding throughout the body).

## Q. What are the warning signs that your dog may be experiencing heat-related illness?

- ✓ Slowing of activity
- ✓ Anxious
- √ Seeking shade
- ✓ Can't get comfortable
- ✓ Panting heavily
- ✓ Lying down
- √ Acute collapse

Many dogs may not drink water when heat exhaustion or heatstroke is imminent, as they are mostly concerned with getting rid of body heat, so they will pant excessively and will not stop to drink water.

#### Q. What should you do if you suspect your dog is experiencing heat-related illness?

- ✓ Stop all strenuous activity
- ✓ Take to a cool or shaded area.
- ✓ Try to offer water
- ✓ Douse with lukewarm water
- ✓ Take immediately to veterinarian

## Q. What are some preventative measures you can take against heat-related illness in your dog?

- ✓ Do not exercise your dog in hot, humid weather, especially if your dog is not acclimated to the climate.
- ✓ If it is hot and you are active with your dog, make frequent water stops.
- ✓ You can have a baby pool filled with water for your dog to jump into after the activity or use a water hose to wet down your dog afterwards.
- ✓ Have the phone number and location of the nearest veterinary emergency clinic readily available.

Heat-related illness is preventable, and with intensive medical care, can be treatable; however, if you have any suspicion that your dog may be affected, quickly cooling them with lukewarm water and immediate transportation to the veterinarian will be lifesaving!

### **BEWARE OF WASPS' NESTS**




